Consider and approve Ordinance O-24-10 of the City Council of the City of Glenn Heights, Texas approving new rates for ATMOS Energy Corp., MID-TEX Division in response to the Company's third rate review mechanism (RRM) filing in all cities exercising original jurisdiction; declaring existing rates to be unreasonable; adopting tariffs that reflect just and reasonable rates; extending the RRM process for two cycles and adopting a new RRM tariff, including cost recovery for a steel service line replacement program; adopting a savings clause; determining that this ordinance was passed in requirements of the Texas Open Meetings Act; declaring and effective date; and requiring delivery of this ordinance to the Company. 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading
