Containers will be available for City residents to dispose of household trash and debris at no charge. A brush chipper and secure sensitive document paper shredder will be available onsite from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 12.



- Appliances can be disposed at this location.
- If you have refrigerators or air conditioning units the Freon must be removed with the appliance properly tagged by a licensed technician.
- E-Waste Collection – 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday, November 12 (i.e., computer terminals, monitors, keyboards, etc.).
- You may bring brush, tires, lumber, junk, metal, lead acid batteries, brick, concrete, and other such material.
- Bring old cell phones and old prescription glasses to be recycled.

Items that **cannot be disposed of include:** paint, chemicals, fuel, oil, cfc light bulbs and fluorescent light tubes or any toxic or hazardous waste. No tube type televisions.



The Clean-Up is for Glenn Heights' residents only and you will need proof of residency with identification, including a driver's license and a water bill.
