



Initiation of Drought Contingency Plan Stage 2

The City of Glenn Heights Drought Contingency Plan stipulates the implementation of drought stages to conserve water when certain criteria have been met. In accordance with the City of Dallas initiation of a Stage 1 Drought Contingency Plan, effective **December 12, 2011, the City of Glenn Heights will enter a mandatory Stage 2 Plan.** These determinations are a result of predictions that the drought will continue at least through summer 2012, and existing reservoirs will continue to be depleted by consumption and evaporation.

The primary impact of the Glenn Heights Drought Contingency Plan is to limit irrigation of landscaped areas to a maximum of twice per week. The mandatory schedule allows residents and businesses with addresses ending in an even number to water on Sundays and Thursdays, while addresses ending in an odd number may water on Saturdays and Wednesdays.
