The City Council of the City of Glenn Heights has called a Bond Election for a total of \$15,500,000 to meet the City's needs in the immediate future.

## Propositions to Appear on the Ballot

### Proposition Number 1

FOR

"The issuance of \$8,000,000 General Obligation Bonds for City Hall located within the Town Center Site and the levy of a tax therefor."

"The issuance of \$7,500,000 General Obligation Bonds for street improvements and the levy of a tax therefor."

## How the Money is Intended to be Used

### Proposition 1: Construction and equipping of a City Hall

It is anticipated that the City Hall will have the following features:

- Citizen Resource Center
- Emergency Shelter
- Emergency Operation Center
- Conference/rental room for gatherings
- Council Chambers

### Proposition 2: Street and Related Improvements

It is anticipated that the following streets will be addressed:

- Roadway Rehabilitation:
  - On the entirety of Hampton Road and
  - On the entirety of Uhl Road
- Bear Creek from Gateway Boulevard to Hampton Road
- Bear Creek Road from I-35 to Gateway Boulevard
