



Household Hazardous Waste Event

June 18, 2011

9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

The City of Glenn Heights, in cooperation with the City of Fort Worth Environmental Collection Center, will host a Household Hazardous Waste Collection event. The City of Fort Worth will have its Crud Cruiser mobile collection trailer onsite on the parking lot. The event is limited to **Glenn Heights residents ONLY**, and does not include commercial or business waste, nor does it include out of city waste.

What's Accepted? Acids, aerosol cans, antifreeze, batteries of all kinds, brake fluid, cooking oil, craft chemicals, degreasers, drain cleaner, fertilizer, fluorescent light bulbs, compact fluorescent light bulbs, herbicides, household chemicals, motor oil, paints and stains, paint thinners, pest strips, pesticides, pharmaceuticals, photo chemicals, oil filters, solvents, transmission fluid and varnish.

What's NOT accepted? Ammunition, asbestos, building material, butane, natural gas or propane cylinders, electronics, explosives, medical waste, PCB's, radioactive material, smoke detectors, tires and TV's.

Capacity is limited! This event will be held from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 am, **or** until the first 50 residents arrive. If trailer capacity is reached before the time has expired or the maximum number of residents arrives, the event will be closed at the discretion of the Fort Worth collection trailer technicians.

Additional instructions for disposing of waste:

- Please provide proper identification (a driver's license or state ID card) and a current Glenn Heights water bill to show proof of residency)
- If a product is usable, give it to someone who can use it instead of bringing it for disposal
- Bring liquid paint sorted by type (i.e., latex, oil based, and lead based)
- Keep chemicals in their original containers: place broken or leaking containers in a second container of like material (i.e., glass for corrosives, metal for flammables)
- If a container has no label and its contents are known, please place a label on the container clearly identifying the contents
- Do not transport chemicals in the passenger compartment of your vehicle, put them in the trunk or bed

NOTATION: Do NOT bring waste from outside of the City of Glenn Heights... it will not be accepted.
